# DAY #4 • Rio De Janeiro / Foz Do Iguaçu

In the morning you will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Foz Do Iguaçu. Upon arrival you will be greeted by your representative and transferred to your hotel. Foz Do Iguaçu is a unique and irresistible destination to the world with many attrations other than the great Falls such as the incredible Itaipu Bio national hydroelectric power plant. Tri-national in formation (Brazilians, Argentineans and Paraguayans) Iguaçu has a cosmopolitan essence and is a land where over 57 ethnical groups live side by side. (B)

## DAY #5 · Foz Do Iguaçu

Spend the day visiting the Iguaçu Falls on the Argentinean side. On the Agentinean side there are different circuits that guarantee close-up contact with the water and rock formations. The main fall, Devil's Throat, is impressive and generates surprise reactions and unexpected showers. (B)

## DAY #6 • Foz Do Iguaçu / Salvador

In the morning, enjoy a guided visit to the Brazilian side of the falls. The walking tour will take you over catwalks to admire the view of the impressive falls. The brazilian side is blessed with the best panoramic views. In the afternoon you will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Salvador. Upon arrival you will be greeted by your representative and transferred to the hotel. Those who have enjoyed Salvador da Bahia know that it is impossible to resist to the temptations of the city offers its visitors - a luch tropical setting, a culture rich in popular traditions and festivals, and an exciting history of bravery and adventure. #### DAY #7 · Salvador

Begin your day with a tour to visit the Cidade Alta (the Upper District). Salvador is divided in two parts: Cidade Baixa (Lower district) and Cidade Alta (Upper District) - which were developed at the bottom and on the top of a cliff of a hundred meters. Many narrow cobble streets, streetcards and elevators connect the two areas. The Upper district is the original city and shelters the antique area, the main monuments and the financial, administrative and cultural centers. The rich baroque architecture is a permanent source of discoveries. Salvador's rich religious past is responsible for the actual title of "The City of 365 Churches". Spend the remainder of the day wondering through streets to discover this alluring destination. (B)
